Training Objectives

Participants will learn the theoretical underpinnings of EFT, as well as how to:

- Assess couples' suitability for EFT
- Work through the 9 steps of EFT
- Elicit and work with emotion as it occurs in the sessions
- Develop specific interventions to help couples reprocess negative affect and foster a more secure bond
- Work through blocks in therapy
- The format provides participants with opportunities to work through experiential skills building exercises and observe the trainers work with a couple on-site. (The latter depends on referrals by course participants of a couple, and appropriate screening by the trainers.)
- Registration is limited to 22 participants in each session. All training material and refreshment breaks are included in fees. Attendees are urged to read the recommended text, *The Practice of Emotionally Focused Marital Therapy: Creating Connection* by Dr. Susan M. Johnson, before the first session.
- Follow-up supervision groups and advanced training opportunities will be available in the future, ensuring participants have the tools and on-going support needed to integrate the EFT model into practice.
